II. Item No.1:-

Confirmation of the Minutes of the Nineth Meeting of
the Board.

The Board considered and confirmed minutes of the Nineth meeting of the Board.

III. Item No.2:-

Follow up action on the decision taken in the IX th meeting of the Board.

The Board took review of the follow^{up} action taken on the decision taken in IXth meeting of the Board.

The Chairman briefed the Board on further development ~~in~~ the issue related to effluent standards applicable to Hindustan Ciba Geigy Ltd. He also informed the members that ~~reply is not~~ received from the Ministry of Environ. & Forests, New Delhi to the reference made to them, requesting clarification on the standards prescribed under E.P. Act, 1986 for pesticide manufacturing industries. Chairman further informed that Member Secretary of the Board has been instructed to ~~p~~ursue the matter with the concerned officer of the Ministry during his next visit to New Delhi.

Director of Industries & Mines informed the members that his department has already perused the list of small scale industries proposed to be kept outside purview of the Board and evolved a list giving due consideration to the local conditions ^{and} which has been forwarded to department of S.T.E. The Board [^]desired that the new list proposed by Director of Industries and Mines may be examined by the Technical Committee and opinion of the Committee may be communicated to the Government.

The Board perused the latest development in the matter pertaining to M/S. Vimal Graphics and desired that Director of Industries and Mines may follow up the matter to its logical end.

The Board desired that Technical Committee may examine the equipments installed by M/s. Mandovi Pellets before commencement of its production.

While discussing the issue of dumping excess fish catch in the river the members suggested that creation of economically viable alternative to utilise the excess catch may solve the problem more effectively. The Chairman informed the members that a proposal of installation of fish meal plant is under consideration with the Government. Simultaneously, the proposal of the Board for levying collective fine on the fishermen functioning in the affected area is being considered by the Government for its effective application.

The list of Iron Ore Benefication plants in operation and proposal for a visit of the Chairman, given by D.I.M. in pursuance of decision taken in previous meeting of the Board was examined by the Chairman. The Chairman desired that all the benefication plants in operation may be included in the list to make it a fully informative document. Selection of particular plants for the visit shall be made thereafter.

IV. Item No.3:-

Minutes of XXXIII rd Meeting of the Technical Committee

The Board perused and accepted the recommendations made in the XXXIII rd meeting of the Technical Committee.

While discussing the recommendation the Board suggested that the Committeemay find out the measures required to be taken for restoration of environmental setup damaged by the action of the production of clay

bricks and introduce a set of conditions to that effect in the N.O.C. issued to the clay bricks manufacturing unit. The Chairman suggested that the Committee may visit the site of the Bricks manufacturing unit located near Quepem to collect on-site information. He further suggested that D.I.M. may provide information on the guidelines followed by the Mining Department while giving clearance to such activities.

Shri Shrivaniand Salgaokar, member desired to know more details about the following NO.C. applications cleared by the Committee:-

- i) M/s. Madgavkar Polycril Pvt. Ltd.
- ii) M/s. Interface Coatings
- iii) M/s. National Coating Co.

The Chairman directed the Member Secretary to furnish the relevant information to the interested members.

The members desired that regular monitoring of final effluent from the Five Star Hotels may be taken up to observe implementation of consent conditions. The Chairman desired that the present conditions of the effluent treatment plant of M/s. Ramada Renaissance Resort may be examined thoroughly in pursuance to the six months time period granted to the Resort, for full loading of the plant.
