26/126/DP/Scheme-Garbage/04/298

Proposed Scheme for Collection,  
Transportation, Segregation, Storage,  
Processing and Disposal of Garbage  
in the Panchayat Area of the  
State of Goa

1. This Scheme may be called the Rural  
Garbage Disposal Scheme 2005. In this scheme  
unless the context otherwise requires,

(a) "Act" means the Goa Panchayat Raj Act,  
1994 (Goa Act 14 of 1994).

(b) "Block Development Officer" means a  
person appointed as Block Development Officer  
by the Government.

(c) "Board" - means the Goa State Pollution  
Control Board constituted under the Water  
(Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974.

(d) "Collection" means lifting and removal  
of solid wastes from collection points or any  
other locations.

(e) "Composting" means a controlled process  
involving microbial decomposition of organic  
material.

(f) "Construction Debris" means wastes from  
building materials, debris and rubble resulting  
from construction, re-modelling, repair and  
demolition operation.

(g) "Designated Village Panchayat" means the  
Village Panchayat within whose the jurisdiction  
of garbage disposal site is located.

(h) "Director" means the person appointed by  
the Government under the Goa Panchayat Raj  
Act 1994, as the Director of the Department of  
Panchayats.

(i) "Disposal of Garbage" is used in its broad  
sense to include the entire management of  
collection, segregation, storage, treatment,  
recycling, reuse, etc. of Garbage in an  
environmentally sound manner.

(j) "Generator of wastes" means persons or  
establishments generating solid wastes in  
Panchayat area.

(k) "Panchayat" means a Village Panchayat  
established under section 3 of the Act.

(l) "Panchayat solid waste" includes  
commercial and residential wastes generated in  
the Panchayat or notified area in either solid or  
semisolid form excluding industrial hazardous  
wastes but including treated bio-medical  
wastes.

(m) "Processing" means the process by  
which solid wastes are transformed into new or  
recycled products.

(n) "Recycling" means the process of transforming segregated solid wastes into raw materials for producing new products, which may or may not be similar to the original products.

(o) "Sarpanch" means a person elected as Sarpanch in accordance with the provisions of the Act.

(p) "Schedule" means a schedule appended to this Scheme.

(q) "Secretary" means the Secretary of the Village Panchayat.

(r) "Segregation" means to separate the Panchayat solid wastes into the groups of organic, inorganic, recyclable and hazardous wastes.

(s) "Storage" means the temporary containment of Panchayat solid wastes in a manner so as prevent littering, attraction to vectors, stray animals and excessive foul odour.

(t) "Transportation" means conveyance of Panchayat solid wastes from place to place hygienically through specially designed transport system so as to prevent foul odour, littering, unsightly conditions and accessibility to vectors.

(u) "Vermicomposting" is a process of using earthworms for conversion of bio-degradable wastes into compost.

2. This scheme shall come into force with effect from the date on which it is published in the Gazette shall extend to all Panchayat areas in the State of Goa.

3. *Sites for Disposal of Garbage.*— For the purpose of practicability and convenience of all Village Panchayats various Developed Village Panchayats and Less Developed Village Panchayats have been grouped into different Clusters of Village Panchayats (CVPs) as indicated in Schedule I appended here to.

4. Designated Village Panchayats within whose jurisdiction the garbage is to be disposed off are indicated at the top of each of the CVPs in the said Schedule I attached to this scheme.

5. Each of the Designated Village Panchayats shall identify a suitable site admeasuring upto

5000 sq. mts. (approximately) for disposal of garbage within 30 days from the date of coming into force of this scheme and inform the concerned Block Development Officer who in turn shall refer the matter to the State Pollution Control Board for their clearance from the angle of pollution.

6. *Acquisition of land.*— After selection of the site the concerned Designated Village Panchayat shall prepare a sketch of the selected site and submit the proposal to the concerned Block Development Officer in the prescribed form alongwith the required documents within 60 days from the date of coming into force of this scheme.

7. The Block Development Officer upon receipt of the proposal from the Designated Village Panchayat shall carry out an inspection of the site alongwith the Extension Officer (R.E.) and after satisfying himself shall submit the proposal to the Director within fifteen days from the date of receipt of the proposal from the Designated Village Panchayat for obtaining the approval from the Government.

8. The Director on scrutinizing the said proposal shall submit the same to the Government for Administrative Approval and expenditure Sanction within a week from the date of receipt of the said proposal in his Directorate.

9. On obtaining the Administrative Approval Expenditure Sanction the Director shall move the proposal to the Government for acquisition of land by recommending the application of the "urgency clause" as provided under Section 17 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (Central Act No.1 of 1894).

10. *Cost of land.*— The cost of land acquisition shall be borne by the Government and for this purpose the Director shall make an adequate provision under the appropriate Budget Head of the Directorate of Panchayats.

11. The concerned Block Development Officer after submitting the proposal for Land Acquisition to the Director, shall simultaneously and with the help of the Department of Science, Technology & Environment and Goa State Pollution Control Board prepare drawings and estimates for construction of a compound wall and other facilities required

for the disposal of garbage, and submit it to the Director for Administrative Approval and Expenditure Sanction.

12. The concerned Block Development Officer shall take over the possession of the acquired land from the Land Acquisition Officer.

13. The concerned Block Development Officer, after taking possession of the acquired land from the Land Acquisition Officer and on receipt of the Administrative Approval and Expenditure Sanction, shall take steps for construction of the compound wall and other facilities in accordance to the C.P. W. D. Manual.

14. The concerned Block Development Officer shall thereafter hand over the possession of the Garbage Disposal Site to the Designated Village Panchayat through the Secretary, and hand over the certificate of transfer to the Director for maintaining the necessary record in his office. One copy of the said certificate shall be retained by the Block Development Officer for his record.

15. (a) Collection of Garbage and its proper disposal shall be the prime responsibility of the sarpanch and the secretary. They shall be accountable for the statutory obligations provided in the Act as well as in Goa Non-Biodegradable Garbage (Control) Act, 1996.

(b) Failure to carry the said duties shall be construed as a serious lapse in discharge of their duties and functions and shall attract stringent disciplinary action.

(c) Each Village Panchayat shall be duty bound to collect the garbage from their jurisdiction as prescribed under the provisions of the Goa Non-Biodegradable Garbage (Control) Act, 1996 and the Rules framed thereunder.

(d) The Designated Village Panchayat shall segregate the said garbage into its Wet (biodegradable) and Dry (non-biodegradable) components.

(e) Biodegradable (wet) garbage shall be transported, stored and treated by composing or vermicomposting on the garbage disposal sites maintained by the Designated Village Panchayats.

(f) Non-Biodegradable garbage shall be disposed off by the Designated village Panchayat in consultation with the Department of Science,

Technology and Environment, and the Goa State Pollution Control Board.

(g) All bio-medical waste shall be compulsorily collected separately from the source, and shall not be mixed with other garbage under any circumstances. The collected bio-medical waste shall be disposed off independently as per the expert advice of the Goa state Pollution Control Board.

16. The Government shall bear the entire cost of maintenance and running of the garbage disposal sites for the first 3 years and thereafter it shall be the responsibility of the concerned Designated Village Panchayat to manage the garbage by levying and collecting utility charges from the persons or establishments generating Panchayat solid wastes.

17. The Designated Village Panchayat shall be encouraged to explore the possibility of selling their composted garbage for organic farming. The Department of Agriculture and Horticulture and the Department of Science, Technology & Environment shall assist the Panchayat in this process.

18. The Designated Village Panchayat shall take full advantage of and shall extend their full co-operation to, any Common Garbage Treatment Complex (CGTC) if of and when established on a commercial basis by the Government through a competent private and professional entrepreneur.

19. *Garbage Tax.*— The Panchayat shall levy garbage tax, fees or service charges in accordance with the provision of the Act.

20. The cost of collection, transportation, segregation, storage, processing and disposal of garbage will be borne by the Government to the extent of 98% and 2% will be borne by the Designated Village Panchayat for the first 3 years and on the expiry of this period, the entire cost shall be borne jointly by each of the CVPs.

21. The Designated Village Panchayat shall be entitled to receive such amount as may be notified by the Government from time to time from each Village Panchayat falling within the group for collection, transportation, segregation, storage, processing, disposal etc.

22. The Designated Village Panchayat shall ensure that no unauthorized person will make use

of the Garbage Disposal Site by any other Village Panchayat other than the Village Panchayat belonging to its CVPs.

23. The technical help/advice will be provided to the Panchayat or to the Block Development Officer by the Department of Science, Technology and Environment and/or the Board as and when needed.

24. This scheme shall be strictly implemented by the Village Panchayats as soon as it comes into force, as per the provisions of the Goa Non-Biodegradable garbage (Control) Act, 1996, and failure to implement the same shall be liable for strict action as contemplated under the provisions of the Goa Panchayat Raj Act, 1994 and other relevant Act in force.

This scheme is in concurrence with Finance Department vide their U. O. No. 580 dated 20-1-2005.
