ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT REPORTS SUBMITTED BY INDUCTION FURNACE UNITS IN KUNDAIM, MADKAIM, WITH REGARDS TO DISPOSAL OF SLAG.

The members approved the Environment Impact Assessment (EIA) reports submitted by the units in Kundaim, Madkai and Cuncolim Industrial Estate and decided to direct all the induction furnace units, submerged arc furnace units and ferro alloy units generating slag to identify laterite quarries to dispose the slag generated from the unit as per the recommendations of the EIA report and the recommendations made by National Environmental Engineering Research Institute (NEERI), Nagpur.

The members also decided that the unit should be directed to submit an action plan for the same and start the disposal in the quarries and the existing waste disposed within their premises should be provided with drains, plantation of vegetation over the cover, construction of retaining walls wherever required prior to the monsoons.

ENHANCEMENT OF CONSOLIDATED SALARY FOR THE CONSULTANT APPOINTED BY THE BOARD

The members approved for amendment in the Rule 22 of the Goa Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Rules, 1988, as amended for enhancement of the consolidated salary to be appointed by the Board from the present Rs. 10,000 to upto Rs. 20,000/0 per month

CARRYING OUT AMBIENT AIR QUALITY MONITORING TWICE A WEEK IN AREAS AFFECTED DUE TO TRANSPORTATION OF IRON ORE.
