



Service Name: Authorization under the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016

The Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 in Goa are managed by the Goa State Pollution Control Board (GSPCB). If a business in Goa generates or handles hazardous waste, it must seek authorization from the GSPCB. The business needs apply for authorization, duly mentioning the detailed inventory of the quantity and nature of the hazardous waste, as well as a description of safety measures and equipment used in handling such waste.

CIRCULAR

The Board at its 157th meeting held on 09th January, 2024, had approved for Amending of fees for authorization issued by the Board under (a) Hazardous Waste Authorization (b) E-Waste authorization (c) Municipal Solid waste Authorization (d) Plastic waste Registration as under:

a.	Hazardous Waste Authorization	Rs. 15,000/- Validity 3 years for issue of such authorization.
b.	E Waste authorization	Rs. 15,000/- Validity 3 years for issue of such authorization.
c.	Municipal Solid waste Authorization	Rs. 15,000/- Validity 3 years for issue of such authorization.
d.	Plastic waste Registration	Fresh registration with validity of one year of Rs. 5,000/- and subsequent renewal application of Rs. 15,000/- for three years.

Further, penalty of 50% shall be imposed on Authorization/Registration fees payable, if the application is not submitted by the date, as prescribed under the concerned Rules for the purpose of renewal.

This Circular supersede the earlier Circular issued by the Board by vide no. 1/8/13-PCB/Vol.XIII/Admn/19795 dated 04/02/2021, except for Battery waste authorization.

CIRCULAR

No. 1/8/13-PCB/Vol.X/Tech/ 14179 **Dated: 30/10/17**

Ref: No. 1/8/13-PCB/Vol.X/Tech/11895 dated 26/09/2017

In partial modification to the above circular para 1, 2 and 5 may be read as follows

1. Inspections pertaining to complaints received by the Board will be conducted within **48 hours** on receipt of the complaint and the inspection report has to be put up online within **48 hours** of post inspection in lieu of Compliance Inspection under The Water (1974) and The Air (1981) Act. **The routine inspection report is also to be put up online within 48 hours of post inspection in lieu of Compliance Inspection under The Water (1974) and The Air (1981) Act.**
- The Analysis report of the sample collected if any, will be completed and the report should be submitted within 04 working days.
2. **Routine inspection** and inspection with respect to any applications received for Red category Small, Medium & Large Scale Category Industries for Consent to Operate/ Renewal of Consent/ Consent to Establish shall be conducted within 7 working days and the Inspection report shall be put up online within **48 hours** post inspection in lieu of Compliance Inspection under The Water (1974) and The Air (1981) Act.
5. The inspection of the units should not be carried out by the same official on two consecutive occasions for applications received for consent to establish/ operate/ renewal/ **routine inspections/ inspections based on complaints** in lieu of Compliance Inspection under The Water (1974) and The Air (1981) Act.



Para 13 and 14 is inserted to the said circular which is as follows:

13. Third Party Certification is allowed for environmental compliance of medium risk category units (orange category) in the State. Any agency/ institute/ body who are empanelled for aforesaid purpose with Central Pollution Control Board or any State Pollution Control Board are hereby authorised for third party certification. In case any wrong information and false certification is found by the Board in the report submitted, the institute will be responsible for the same and would be held liable for de-recognition for third party certification for GSPCB.
14. Online application submission and document upload is mandated for Consent to Operate/ Consent to Establish under the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974; The Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Authorization under the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.

MEMORANDUM

In furtherance of the notification No.3/02/2015-IND/64 dated 25/01/2021 issued by the Department of Industries, Government of Goa, the Goa Investment Promotion and Facilitation Board (Goa-IPB), State's implementation agency for Ease of Doing Business, hereby issues the following mandates as outlined below:-

1) Further to point 3 of the above mentioned notification, the online system for Public Consultation has been implemented in the State to ensure the following for all proposed regulations in the State:

- i. Legal basis
- ii. Necessity
- iii. Business friendly policies
- iv. The drafts of proposed acts, rules or regulations should be made available for a minimum period of 30 days

All departments of the State Government are to note the above four points while drafting and proposing any legislation, rules or regulations.

2) Furthermore, the online single window system and all online services should have the following features:

- i. End-to-end online application and submission
- ii. Online payment and document submission
- iii. Online status tracking and department comments
- iv. Online certificate issuance and download
- v. Facility for online verification of certificates/ licenses/ permits by third parties

All Departments of the State Government and their IT vendors concerned should make sure that any service made online should have above mentioned features for the online systems used and developed by them.

Additional Remarks: The procedural steps indicated above is uniform for all types of establishments, irrespective of risk category, size of firm, business location or type of investor (Foreign or Domestic).
